What is the Korean Studies Scholarship?

Silla University offers a wide variety of programs for our students. The 『Department of Korean Studies』 provides scholarships to International students who wish to pursue their B. A. degree as a Major of Korean Studies in Korea. International Studies Division has two departments, 『Dept. of International Relations』 for domestic students and 『Dept of Korean Studies』 for international students.

Who may receive the scholarship?

- International students those who wish to pursue their B. A. at Silla University.
- Students who have TOEFL 550, IELTS 5.5 or above.
- Both applicant and his/her parents must be citizens of a foreign country.
※ Applicants can't have Korean citizenship.
- Applicants should be in good health, both mentally and physically, to stay in Korea for the duration of the program.
※ Submit official Medical Assessment when you apply.
If students are unable to complete the program due to health problems, the scholarship may be cancelled.
- Should be under 30 years of age as of September 1, 2013.

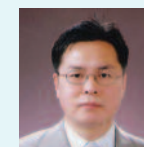
